Closest to the handle, which represents you, the seeker, is a gap. In fact, the gap from the rim extends over more than half the cup and is blocked by a hard, distinct line. The line is thickest under the handle, as if you don't want to deal with anyone (work, friends, family), and especially yourself. Right now, you want space from everyone and the open rim is intentional. Swimming directly under the line by the handle is a scuba diver. Water is always in the realm of feelings, and this entire cup has a "washed" feeling and look, as if you are drowning in your emotions. The scuba diver represents a plunge into emotional uncertainty or even negativity. A broken circle just under the diver speaks to a promise that has been broken, possibly relating to a close relationship with a partner or friend.

On the Emotional side of the cup there is a frowning face just above a mermaid. While mermaids are beautiful, they are also dangerous. There is a female energy present who you should consider more like a mythic siren than Disney's Ariel. Another water creature, hinting again to emotional turmoil. The frown reinforces this. Next to her is a distinct 2. In numerology, 2 is about union, peace, and loyal partners. But a rat is attached to the 2, as if a 3rd party has infiltrated the peace of your 2. Rats represent envy and enemies, gnawing at your union. Beneath them is a squirrel; perhaps a friend reminding you it's time to step back, save your nuts, and prepare to hunker down.

Towards the end of the rimmed opening, a wolf head; this is someone at a distance offering you strength and protection on this stormy path. At the back of the cup, a time of 6-ish months from now, are a large hair dryer and an acorn. The hair dryer invites you to stop dwelling on your problems—to blow them away, and the acorn suggests new opportunities.

On the Material side, which represents jobs/career/money or home/car/stuff, there is a scatter, suggesting you aren't sure what you want from your work. Beneath that, a set of steep stairs. The stairs are the largest symbol in the cup. They suggest that to overcome your professional obstacles, you need to work hard and keep pressing to get where you're going. It's likely to be a challenging climb.

About halfway back the cup, the letters L and S. These can be a significant person, place or thing and are about 2-3 months from you. Beneath the letters, a lasso. It suggests you will have to chase down your goals with focus and effort. They aren't going to just land in your lap.

Attached to the stairs and crossing the cup is a broken line that lands on a broken triangle. The line suggests you will struggle up the steps, as the line starts there, with the hope of the triangle at the end of the journey. Triangles are about opportunities, but the way this one is presenting, it's likely you will miss out on something, and about 6 months from now, you will realize the prize slipped through your fingers.

Past the triangle is a man's boot kicking a heart. These relate to feeling like you were booted from a place or situation you loved relating to your home or work, possibly by a male energy. At the back of the cup, the letters CC. While this can be shorthand for "carbon copy," it is more likely a person, place, or thing that will manifest into your life in about 6 months.

In the very bottom the cup, four ghosts are waiting for you in the distant future. Ghosts are always about dealing with issues and people from the past. In this case, 4 major parts of your past will demand attention as you move through the rest of this year.
